To keep serious, while there is obviously an infinite amount of things to learn, our way of looking at it is this:

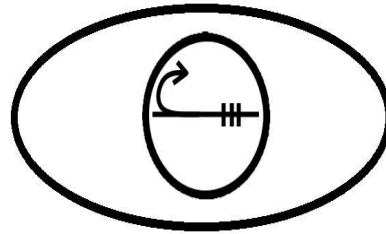
The universe works in certain cycles, and the cycle of creation is as follows:

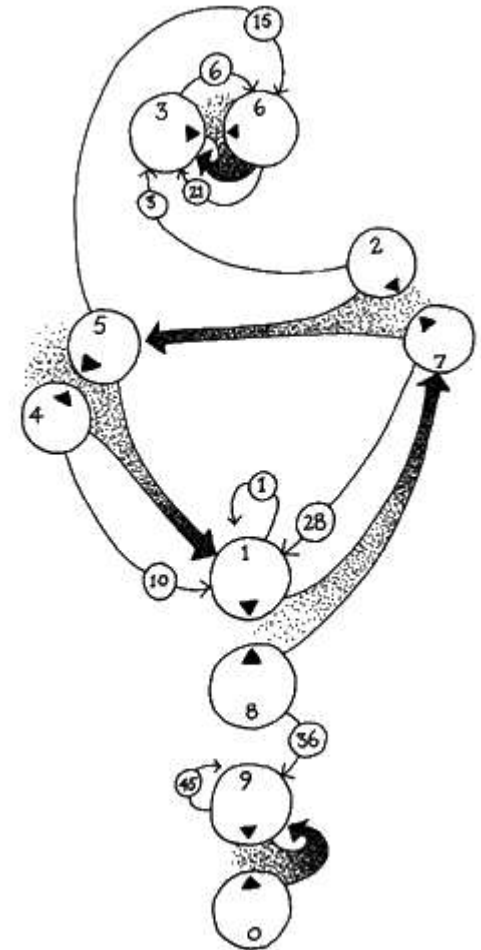
But at the end of the day, this is our way of looking at truth. Your way may be different, but it will never be wrong. Learn for yourself.
